Canadian rock band “**The Last Supper**” land in South Africa on the 10th of December. Over a whirlwind eleven-day period, they will perform eight shows in Gauteng, Mpumalanga and Kwa-Zulu Natal. Their easy-listening alternative rock sound will be coupled with SA rockers **Cutting Jade, Lonehill Estate** and many more! Throughout their tour, they will be filming the experience for a reality TV series called **Band Without Borders** which documents their tour around the world and showcases the good, the bad, the unexpected and the extraordinary that goes with being a touring band. So come along and show the world how awesome South Africans are and how much we love to rock!

“**The Last Supper**” was voted as one of the 20 top new bands in 2006 by Classic Rock Magazine and now they’re coming to South Africa to show us why. The band was formed by vocalist Daniel Shwetz and guitarist Peter Walker in 1996 when they were at Varsity. Their influences range from rock and blues to hip-hop and the spice of their Egyptian percussionist Diaan Tass. Bassist Scott Herndon and drummer Jason Woodley complete the 5-piece line-up.

They have already played over 600 shows across four continents with the likes of **Iron Maiden, Our Lady Peace, Thin Lizzy, KISS, Sex Pistols, Incubus, Ministry and Peter Dinklage**. Now they are coming to share the stage with South African musicians in December this year.

They have recently released their brand new album “**0° - Order into Chaos**” which reflects 4 years of work in a very listenable, accessible and solid record. It was recorded and produced in a total of 13 studios including ones in L.A., Cairo, Montreal, Ottawa and London. The album includes some well-known Egyptian musicians and the mixing and preproduction credits include Danny Brodbeck (Dolores O’Riorden, The Salads, The Gandharvas) and Mark Sparks (Salt & Peppa, Madonna, Will Smith).

Most importantly “**The Last Supper**” is touring with a film crew as part of a Reality TV show called **Band Without Borders**. The show will document the band’s trek through 100 countries, showcasing life on the road in the pursuit to be the band who has toured the most countries. Everything will be included: backstage scenes, pranks and jokes, shows, fans, the hardships of touring, the friendships made and broken and ultimately the triumph of making it through the strength of their convictions never to split up and never to compromise. They are also placing an emphasis on being environmentally friendly while bringing together cultures and musicians from all over the world.
